Sunshine Circle will partner with the Buffalo Trace health department to host a 9 week program teaching healthy lifestyle choices. The one hour meetings will be at Trinity every Tuesday at 5:30pm starting February 4th through March 31st. We currently have 8 registrants but more are welcome. Bridget Lykins, registered dietician, is the local resource and will guide the video sessions. A different video each week will cover a new topic and participants will journal their experiences. The program is valued at \$140 if registered individually. We are very fortunate to work with Bridget again. Timing of this opportunity is perfect for anyone who has made a new year resolution or will make a Lenten commitment to become more health conscious.

Sunshine Circle will again sponsor the Kentucky UMC Children's Home with funds raised from dues, the sale of Trinity UMC notecards and other projects.

As a reminder, Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 26th. Sunshine Circle will again provide the Lenten calendar with proceeds dedicated to the Mason County school backpack program. A small group from Sunshine Circle will also provide a youth snack supper once each quarter, beginning Sunday, February I 6th.
