#### A New Year's Resolution of Rest

Well, the Christmas season is at an end. The decorations are slowly being put up or already packed. The leftover food is getting to the point that it really needs to be eaten or thrown out. You've made – or think you need to make – your New Year's resolutions, but this ritual usually brings a feeling of insecurity because of all of the resolutions in the past that you never kept.

But, the reality is your greatest need is rest.

During orientation for visitors at the Abbey of Gethsemani, home of the famous 20th century monk Thomas Merton, the monks speak of all the prayer times, meal times in silence, and the like. But, there is a small speech or laid-back homily that goes something like this from the guestmaster monk:

"We have found over the years of opening up our monastery to visitors that most of our guests that live beyond our home are so very busy. Most people come here seeking to be closer to God, but they treat their time here as



an extension of their normal lives. So, they attend every single hour of worship at 3:15 a.m., 5:45 a.m., 6:15 a.m., 7:30 a.m., 12:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m., 5:30 p.m., and 7:30 p.m. You can imagine how this schedule would be grueling for those who have not created this rhythm in their lives. So we have found most guests need to simply sleep and rest for a good two days, before they are able to commune most effectively with God."

When we think about the year ahead, and as we watch videos reviewing the past year on the Internet and TV, it is easy to feel overwhelmed. Give yourself the greatest blessing you can:

rest.

"Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30)

#### **Finance Notes**

As you know our theme for stewardship emphasis for this year was "Spiritual Generosity", and we can now report that our collective family of faith responded "in spirit and truth" to this effort. With essentially all pledges received, we think everyone should be congratulated for their generous response.

For 2019, the total pledges reported were \$205,000.00, which was adjusted to \$202,402.00 when reviewed. This represented 59.07% of the operating budget of our church. There were 50 pledged "giving units" for this period. For 2020, the number of "giving units" increased to 66. The pledged amount for 2020 is \$255,226.00 or 74.48% of the budget. Comparing last year with this year reflects remarkable growth in our spirit of generosity. For example:

The number of giving units increased 32%
The percentage of budget pledged increased 16%
The percentage increase in actual dollars pledged was 26.1%

Measured by the yardstick of financial commitments, we feel that it is appropriate to say "Spiritual Generosity" is alive and well at Trinity! Thanks to all for choosing to demonstrate your faith in this tangible way and thanks be to God, the giver of all good and perfect gifts!


